While standardized testing is not the central point in classrooms at Prince, the successes shown by our students on these tests are a true testament of how well prepared students are at Prince. This past year, 97% of Prince students scored above the ACSI average in all subjects tested. Additionally, the average ACT and SAT scores of our high school students continue to surpass the local public schools. While the importance of

standardized testing is not forgotten, Prince also wants to make sure learning is engaging and fun for the students. With our small class sizes, we are able to incorporate more individualized learning that the students enjoy.

CO-CURRICULAR OPPORTUNITIES. It is truly rare to find a private school of our size that has as many co-curricular opportunities as Prince. It is even rarer to find a school that not only has athletic teams that are ranked top in the state, but also a fine arts department that was recognized at the Shuler Awards. In addition to their successes, I have been very impressed with the collaboration between the two departments. At a school the size of Prince, we have students who may run from band rehearsal over to basketball practice, and numerous other examples. Our students have the unique opportunity to participate in fine arts activities and athletic teams simultaneously. They truly get the best of both worlds.

CARING FACULTY. My first year at Prince I set a goal to observe as many classes as possible to get a better feel for the school. I was blown away by the extra effort the faculty put into building interpersonal relationships with their students. It is evident that our faculty truly care about the well-being of every student. The faculty and staff take the time every Friday morning to pray for students specifically, by name.

HIGHER PURPOSE. While academics, co-curricular activities, and a great faculty are very important components that make Prince so unique, Prince's true mission is to help students with their eternal path after leaving this life.
