2018 Official Information and Guidelines:

Any Robins Financial Credit Union member who will graduate from high school in 2018, and who will be attending a college or university **in the State of Georgia** is eligible to apply. Other conditions that must be met include:

1. Applicants must turn in their **completed** Scholarship Application Packet by Noon, Friday, March 23, 2018. Applications will be **disqualified** if they are missing information or if the application packet is not received by the deadline. **No exceptions.**
2. Applicants must provide an Acceptance Letter from the in-state College or University they plan to attend.
3. Applicants must provide a complete copy of the FASFA Student Aid Report. If not available, the applicant may submit a copy of their parent(s) or guardian(s) 2017 Income Tax Statement. *Previous year's income tax statement will not be accepted.*
4. Applicants must submit a copy of their most recent high school report card to include their cumulative GPA. *Does not have to be an official transcript.*
5. Applicants must complete the Activities & Achievement Form provided by Robins Financial Credit Union. *This information must be given on the form provided, in the space provided. Additional pages, resumes, portfolios, etc will not be considered.*
6. Applicants must submit two letters of recommendation. The letters should not be from the applicant's family member, but from members of the community. (Examples: teachers, managers, pastors, etc.) *Letters should not be submitted in envelopes. Please remove any envelopes and include letters, unfolded, in your packet.*
7. Applicants must submit a typed one-page essay answering the following questions: What does financial responsibility mean to you and how do you manage your finances? How will receiving your college degree help improve your financial future and how can Robins Financial Credit Union help you achieve your financial goals?
8. Applicants **MUST** be a member of Robins Financial Credit Union. You may NOT use a parent/guardian's account.

All applicants will be notified of their selection status, by mail, no later than Monday, April 9, 2018.

Additional Information: Application packets should not include bindings of any kind such as staples, folds, binder clips, etc. Awarded scholarship funds of \$2,000 will be issued directly to the in-state College or University on behalf of the recipient upon providing proof of enrollment. If enrollment verification is not received, or student does not attend an in-State College or University, funds will be forfeited.
