

2021 High School Essay Contest

Judging Criteria:

- * Creativity (Originality; thought provoking)
- * Grammar (Use proper sentence and paragraph structure, correct punctuation, and spelling)
- * Scripture Based (Use Scripture which is meaningfully used and is applicable.)
- * Evidence of Research: Minimum of 4 footnotes or endnotes and at least 3 bibliographical entries, Scripture can only be counted once in bibliography and twice in your footnote/endnote count. A separate bibliography is required.
- * Length: Minimum of 750 words
- * Submit your essay as a pdf.

Include a personal bio sheet with your essay. Include the following information: name; address, email, phone, and church membership and/or name of Christian School.
