

Grassroots Intern | Job Description

Position Summary

The field and grassroots team is at the very core, the backbone of any campaign. They are the frontline staff who are tasked with spreading Senator Perdue's message, identifying supporters, and turning those supporters into voters on Primary Day, May 24th. As a Grassroots Intern you will work with field coordinators (FC's) to mobilize and get out the vote for Senator David Perdue's campaign for Governor.

Responsibilities & Duties

- 1. Volunteer Attraction
 - a. Must be able to identify potential volunteers, know how to gain and maintain their excitement about the election, and then activate their interests across a broad spectrum of engagement opportunities
 - b. Volunteer groups can include, but are not limited to:
 - i. Perdue County Chair and Co-Chairs
 - ii. Local GOP Chairs and members (or affiliates: i.e. Teen Republicans, Young Republicans, Republican Women, etc.)
 - iii. Church groups
 - iv. Veterans organizations
 - v. Neighborhood associations
 - vi. Other civic associations
- 2. Voter Engagement and Activation
 - a. There will be voter engagement and turnout goals each day leading to Election Day
 - b. This engagement will include, but are not be limited to:
 - i. Perdue County Chair and Co-Chair coordination
 - ii. Door knocks (utilizing i360 app technology)
 - iii. Phone calls (utilizing i360 app technology)
 - iv. Organize Super Saturday's
 - v. Yard sign placements

3. Represent

- a. Interns will work with local grassroots coordinators and volunteer to serve as the face of Senator Perdue's campaign and should have a strong presence in their respective communities.
- b. Interns should attend events or even serve as a surrogate speaker (sometimes to individuals, sometimes to large groups) in order to gather and promote support for Senator Perdue. These include, but are not limited to:
 - i. County GOP meetings
 - ii. Other local political events where a Perdue presence is requested or determined to be of value

iii. Perdue voter engagement and turnout events (i.e. Bus Tour, rallies, etc.)
