The camp is organized and hosted by Athens Area Women in Construction (AAWIC), a non-profit corporation comprised of women in the Architecture, Engineering, and Construction (AEC) industry. AAWIC is dedicated to bringing awareness to the AEC industry as a rewarding and exciting career choice for women.

Participation is limited to 12 young women who must be rising high school juniors or seniors in the Athens area community. Participation in the camp for each of these students will be paid for by donations from local AEC companies. Participants must provide their own transportation to and from camp at the beginning and the end of each camp day. There will be a fair amount of walking around the UGA campus.
