The Winterville Civitan Club is pleased to offer two Howard Parrish Memorial Scholarships to assist a deserving student from the Winterville area in attending a university, college or technical college of his or her choice. The amount of each of the scholarship grants will be \$3,000. Each scholarship grant will be payable in two installments to the university, college, or technical college during the first year the student is enrolled.

Applicants must meet the criteria listed below and submit their completed application back to the address on the letterhead, postmarked by April 12, 2025. All applicants will be notified of a decision by April 26, 2025. The formal presentation to the winners will be at the regular dinner meeting of the club on Thursday, May 8, 2025.

Criteria to be eligible for the scholarship:

- 1. Have a Winterville mailing address, a Winterville telephone number, or some other established affiliation with the Winterville Community.
- 2. Be reasonably assured of graduating from high school by June 2025.
- 3. Plan to be enrolled in a recognized university, college or technical college by fall of 2025.
- 4. Submit the attached application to the club, along with the specified supplementary materials.

Selection criteria, in addition to the above, will include scholarship, school and community contributions, financial need, and motivation.
